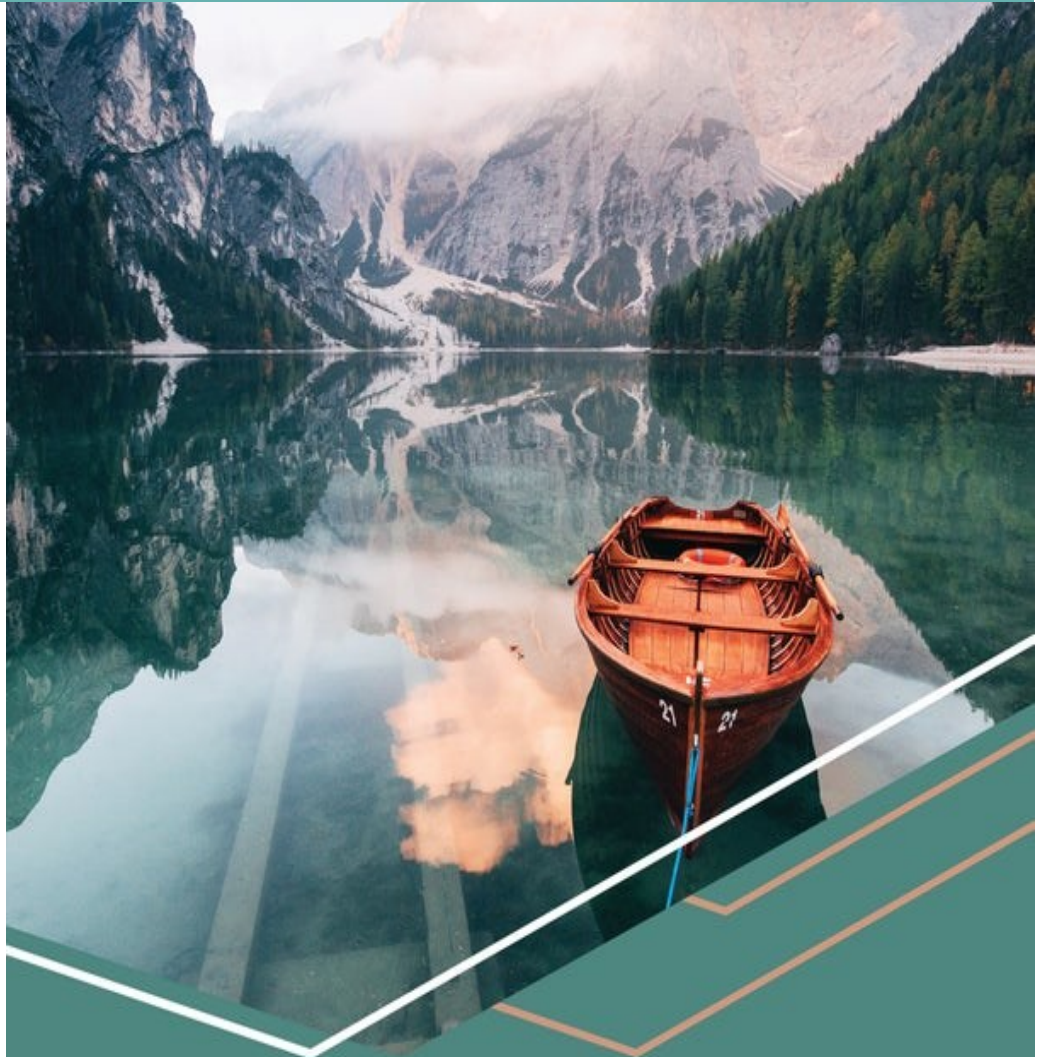

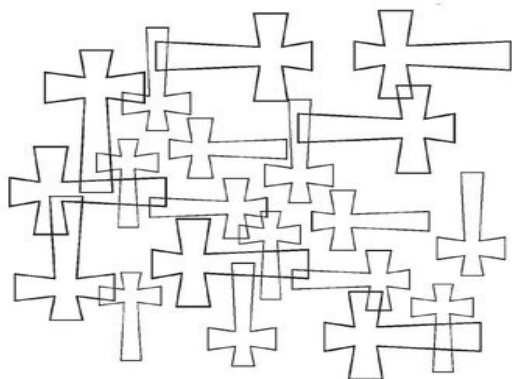
PRAYER
